

HOW TO REPORT A WORKPLACE INJURY

If immediate medical attention is required: Direct the injured employee to the nearest urgent care clinic or emergency facility. Then **report the injury within 24 hours.**

If immediate medical attention is <u>not</u> **required**: Report the injury as soon as possible to have a claims adjuster assigned who can authorize medical treatment.

Florida law requires all workplace injuries be reported within 7 days. If injuries are not reported timely, the State of Florida can fine you up to \$2,000.

If reporting online or via email, add **FUBA** before your 5-digit policy number (no space). Example: FUBA99999

Information needed to report a workplace injury:

- Workers' comp policy number
- Policyholder contact information name, phone number, address, email
- Employee information name, date of birth, contact info, date of hire, SSN, job description
- > Description of the accident
- > Date of accident
